*Extension through January 1, 2021*


**WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2020, a State of Emergency was declared within the City of Orlando as a result of the potential public health threat posed by the spread of the Coronavirus Disease (“COVID-19”); and

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 continues to pose a significant public health threat and a clear and present danger within the City of Orlando community; and

**NOW THEREFORE, I BUDDY DYER**, as Mayor of the City of Orlando and pursuant to the authority vested in me by state laws and Orlando ordinances and in accordance with the provisions of section 43A.03 of the City Code of the City of Orlando, hereby extend the STATE OF EMERGENCY, originally declared by this office on March 13, 2020 until 12:00 midnight on January 1, 2021.
