

STATE OF EMERGENCY

EXECUTIVE ORDER

October
September 1, 2022

WHEREAS, the City of Orlando has suffered from strong winds and heavy rainfall as a result of Hurricane Ian; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this weather event numerous buildings and other structures within the City have suffered severe damage; and

WHEREAS, many of these structures need immediate repairs in order to remediate and mitigate the storm damage; and


WHEREAS, this situation presents a danger to health and safety within the City of Orlando community; and

WHEREAS, it is critical to health and safety within the City of Orlando that emergency repairs be made as promptly as possible;

NOW THEREFORE, I, **BUDDY DYER**, as Mayor of the City of Orlando and pursuant to the authority vested in me by state laws and Orlando ordinances and in accordance with the provisions of chapter 252, Florida Statutes, and sections 43A.02 and 43A.07 of the Code of the City of Orlando, hereby issue this State of Emergency Executive Order for the City of Orlando, with the provisions as follows:

1. City inspectors are authorized to issue building permits in the field for emergency repair of non-structural damage without requiring compliance with normal permit prerequisites; and
2. City inspectors are authorized to waive permit fees for minor non-structural emergency repairs to one and two family dwellings.

This declaration shall be effective immediately upon my execution, this 1st day of ~~September~~ *October*, 2022 and shall be effective through 5 p.m. October 31, 2022 unless otherwise terminated or extended in accordance with applicable law.
